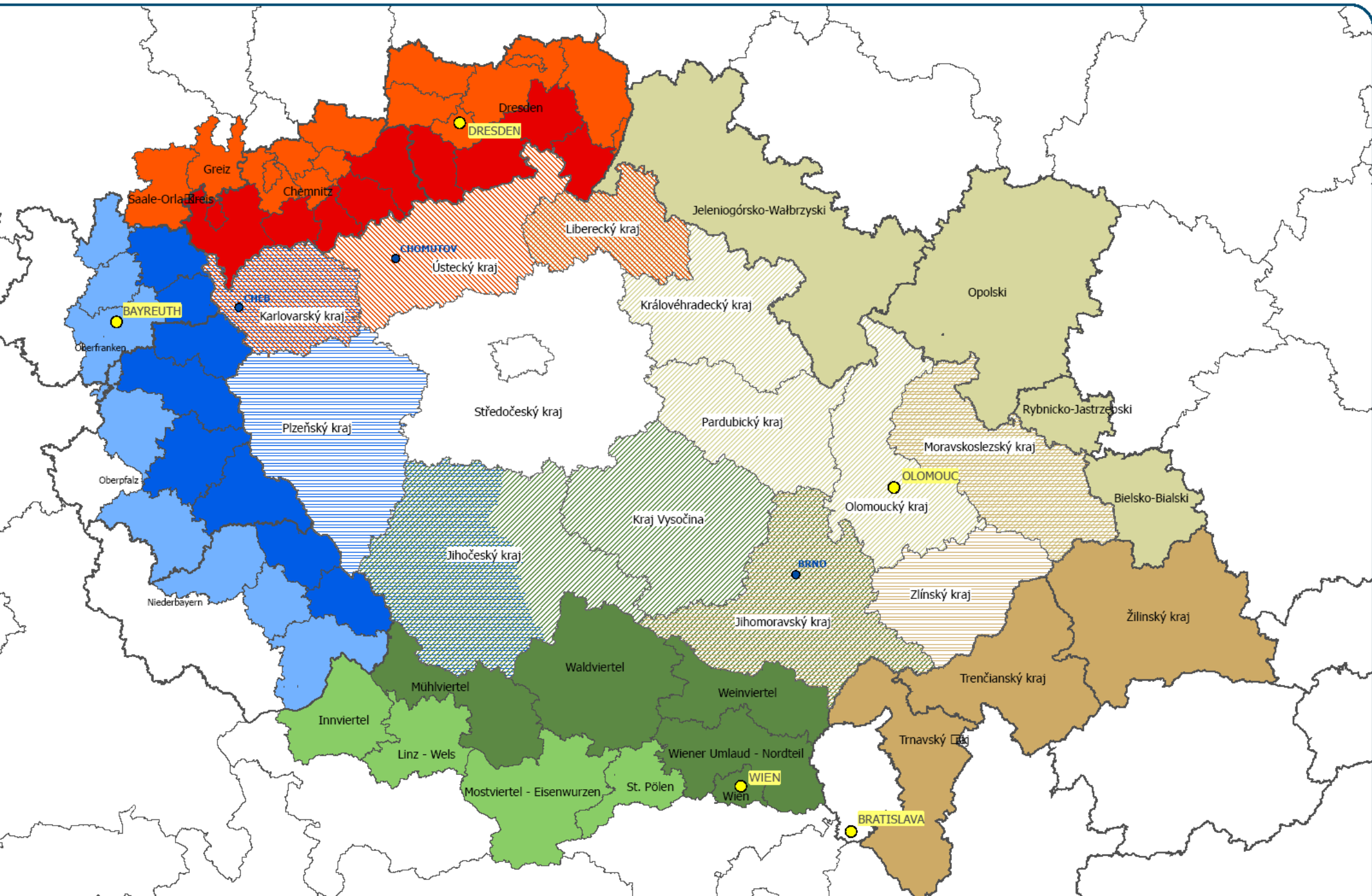

early all potential applicants in measure of Microprojects (small projects from people to people type) call for simplification of the programme implementation procedure especially for simplification of the application form.

or:

project planning;

preparation of the project application;

preparation of the project budget;

evaluation of project application;

steering committee decisions;

preparation of project final statement of account (eligible/ineligible costs);

financial control and final project data evaluation,

detailed and entire information are very important.

Excess of simplifications could be also counterproductive

N+2 risk

CI INTERREG IIA measure of Microprojects represents c. 10% of Community Initiative allocation, i. e. from point of view of N+2 risk is not important,

but

period 2007 -2013 (Objective 3) measure of Microprojects represents Polish border c. 20% i.e. using of N+3/2 will be very relevant fact.

On a level of the individual projects i.e. on the level of Microprojects Management project and Microprojects Administration project is applying of LPP possible and also suitable.

In preparatory discussions in border Euroregions about using of LPP for measure of Microprojects was considered as complicated and inelastic system. At present time border Euroregions mostly recommend to use for measure of Microprojects similar implementation system as in the recent INTERREG programme period and without using LPP.

Nearly all problems in managing of the INTERREG programme are caused by insufficiency of the basic data/information which are given in project application.

The absence of this basic data and information in project application causes also a lot of problems especially

during:

preparation of project final statement of account and making difference between eligible or ineligible costs;

annual financial control;

annual project data evaluation.
